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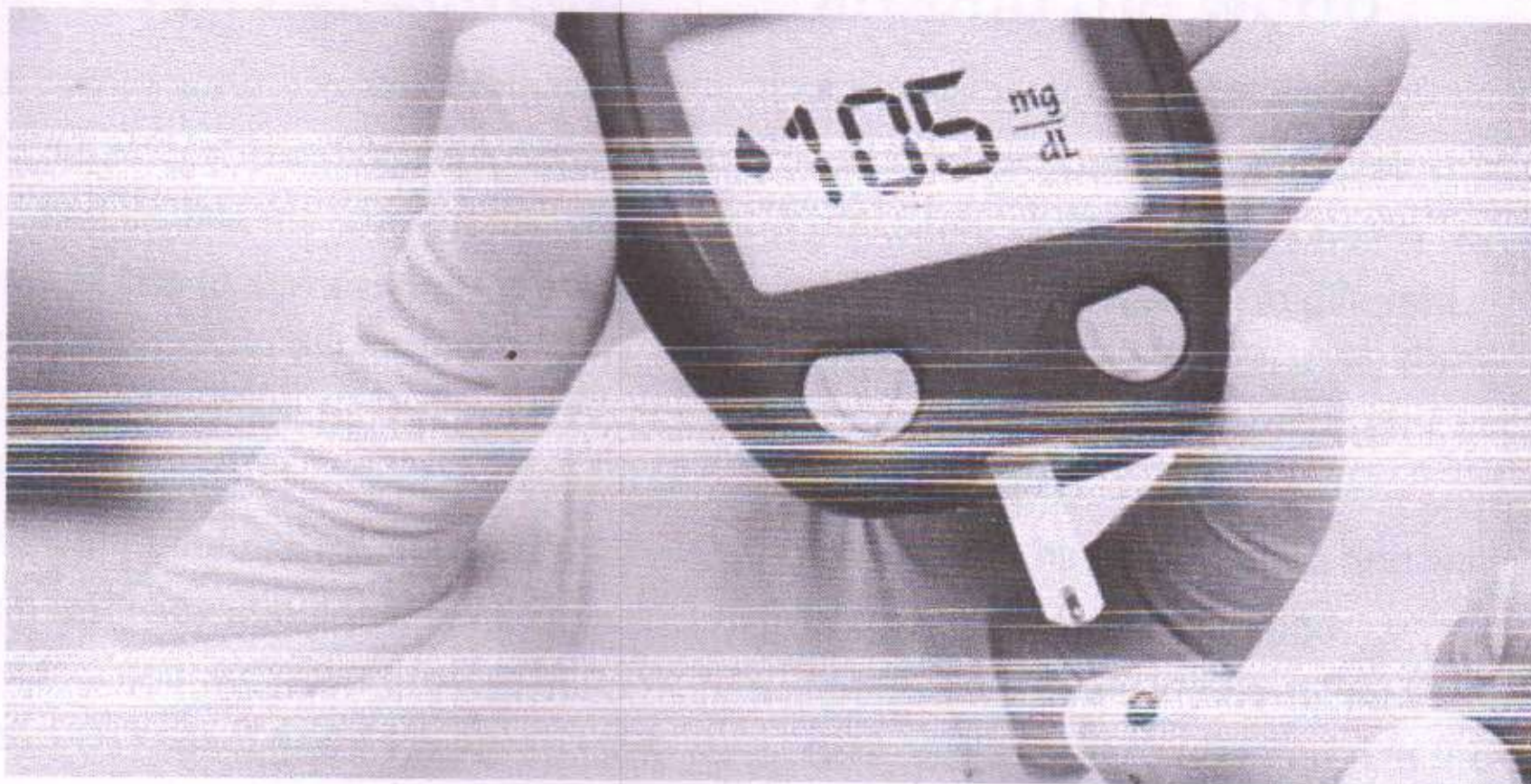
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Historic global accord reached on pandemic prevention, preparedness and response

In a consensus decision, the World Health Assembly last week agreed to kickstart a global process to draft an international instrument under the constitution of the World Health Organization to strengthen pandemic prevention, preparedness and response. WHO director general Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus said the decision represents a once-in-a-generation opportunity to strengthen the global health architecture to protect and promote the well-being of all people. "The COVID-19 pandemic has shone a light on the many flaws in the global system to protect people from pandemics: the most vulnerable people going without vaccines; health workers without needed equipment to perform their life-saving work; and 'me-first' approaches that stymie the global solidarity needed to deal with a global threat," Dr Tedros said. The assembly met in a special session, only the second since the WHO's founding in 1948, and adopted the decision titled: "The World Together". This establishes an intergovernmental negotiating body, which will hold its first meeting by March 2022, to draft and negotiate a WHO convention, agreement or other international instrument on pandemic prevention, preparedness and response. "We welcome this decision and FIP is ready to support this work. Better preparedness will save lives and help reduce unnecessary stress on our healthcare workers, who have to deal with immense challenges during a pandemic," said FIP CEO Catherine Duggan. During the session, member states were urged to ensure protection of and investment in the health workforce in a [joint statement](#) from FIP, World Physiotherapy, the World Dental Federation, the World Medical Association and the International Council of Nurses, under the auspices of the World Health Professions Alliance. The statement drew attention to a deterioration of working conditions and desperate shortages of health professionals, which negatively impact health outcomes and health professionals' well-being.

New handbook to support pharmacists' roles in diabetes care made available by FIP

The role that pharmacists can play in preventing the projected rise in diabetes to 700 million people by 2045 is highlighted in a new resource released last month by FIP. "Diabetes prevention, screening and management: A handbook for pharmacists" provides information on the wide range of pharmaceutical services that pharmacists can provide to reduce the global burden of this disease. "This publication provides pharmacists with everything they need to know to help guide community members to make healthy choices and adopt healthy habits," said Andrew Boulton, president, International Diabetes Federation. In addition to prevention, screening and referral, the handbook covers medicines management, non-pharmacological management and advice, and prevention and management of complications. It also addresses barriers to providing diabetes services. Its publication is part of FIP's new Practice Transformation Programme on Non-Communicable Diseases. FIP has also launched a hub of online resources on non-communicable diseases.

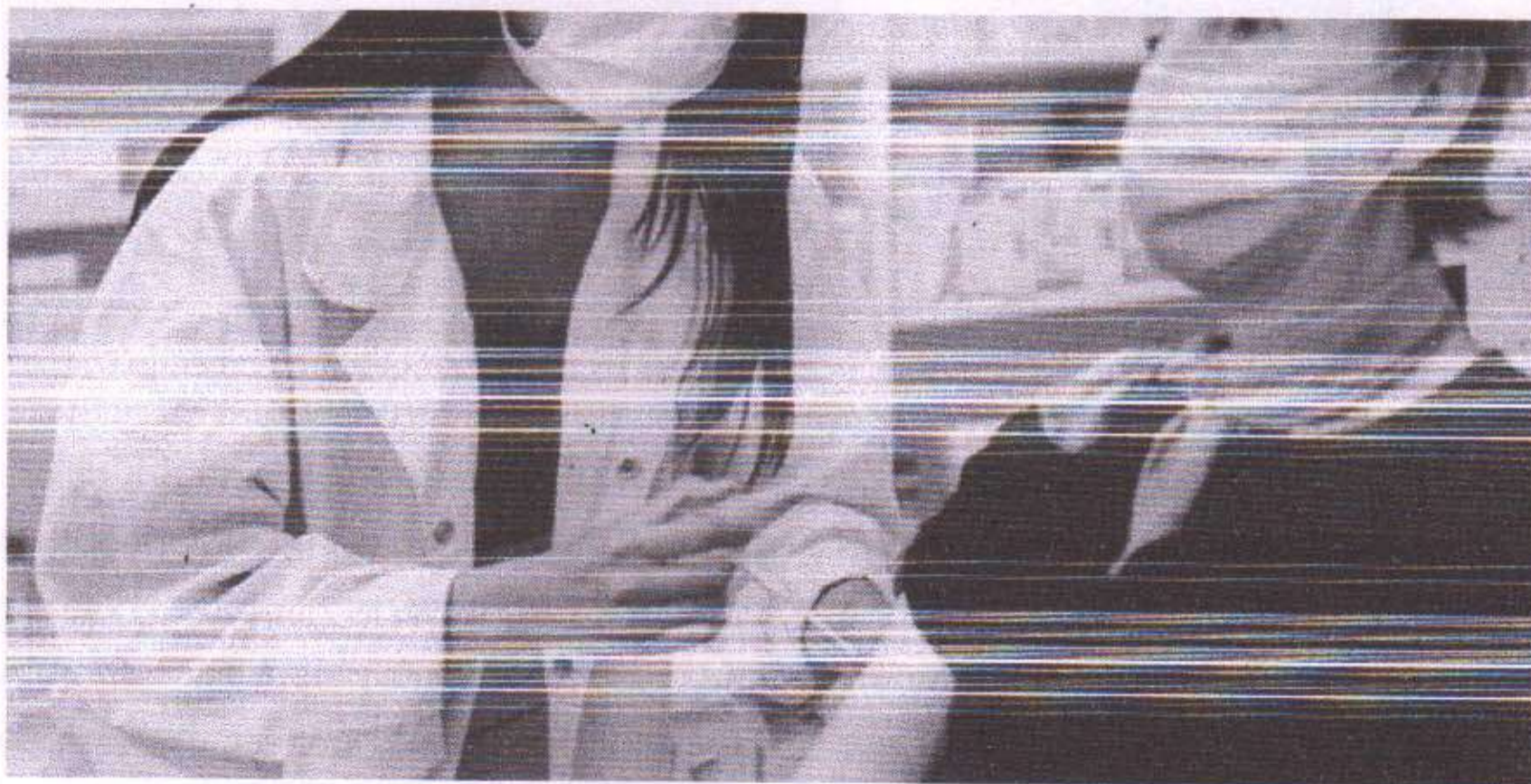
A recent survey by the Portuguese Consumer Protection Association indicates that the Portuguese public would like to see services provided by pharmacies expanded. Among the respondents (n=1,515), 80% found home delivery of medicines to be very useful, 67% agreed that pharmacies should dispense medicines without a prescription in certain cases, and 64% agreed that pharmacists should be able to access their medical histories. The survey also revealed that more than a third of respondents would be willing to pay for certain services, such as vaccination at home.

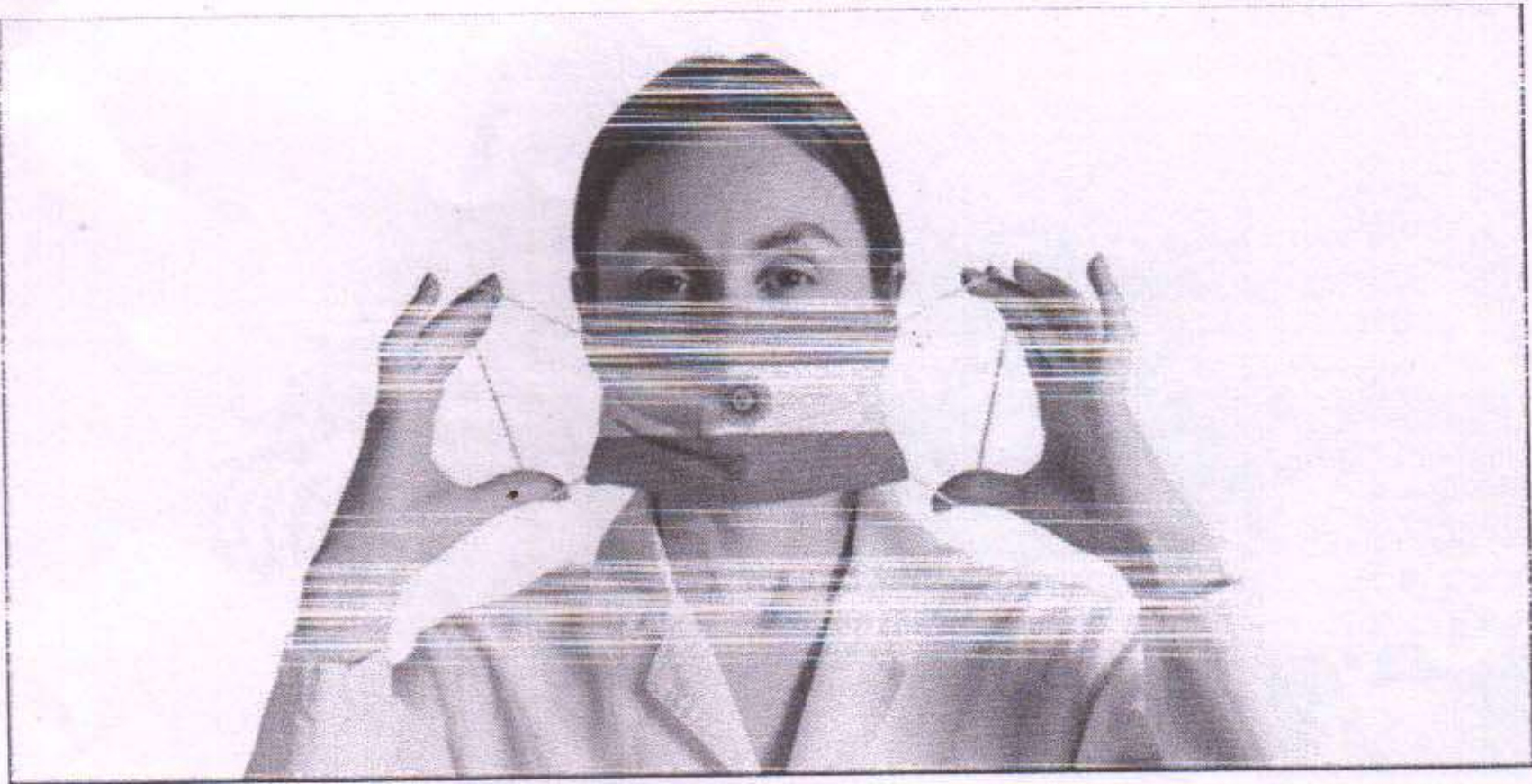

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How pharmacists in Argentina have risen to the challenges of COVID-19

Academics in Argentina report on a survey which shows that community pharmacists are highly valuable to the Argentinian healthcare system as it deals with the COVID-19 pandemic in this article for the *IPJ*. The article highlights the role of pharmacists in primary health care, which was officially recognised by the Argentinian Government last month in a new resolution. The new law describes the role as "health promotion; especially in everything related to supply systems, dispensing, pharmacotherapeutic monitoring, rational use of medicines and other health technologies, patient safety, notification of adverse events, vaccination of the population and optimisation of the use of antimicrobials". It is largely based on a 2013 document produced by the Pan-American Health Organization, which was reviewed by and included contributions from the Pharmaceutical Forum of the Americas and FIP.

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

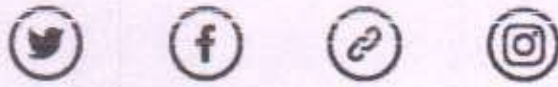
