Description	<p>. A workshop on IPR & Regulatory Guidelines for Pharmaceutical Industries was conducted on 19-01-2018 by Vikas College of Pharmaceutical Sciences. Dr. K. Gouthamrajan, Professor JSS College of Pharmacy, delivered his lecture on IPR and Regulatory Guidelines, Intellectual property (IP) pertains to any original creation of the human intellect such as artistic, literary, technical, or scientific creation. Intellectual property rights (IPR) refers to the legal rights given to the inventor or creator to protect his invention or creation for a certain period of time. These legal rights confer an exclusive right to the inventor/creator or his assignee to fully utilize his invention/creation for a given period of time. From this session students gained knowledge about the basics of IPR and the regulatory guidelines followed by different pharmaceutical industries.</p> <p>The role of the regulatory authorities is to ensure the quality, safety, and efficacy of all medicines in circulation in their country. It not only includes the process of regulating and monitoring the drugs but also the process of manufacturing, distribution, and promotion off. One of the</p>

Epidemiology is the study of the distribution and determinants of

Diseases and other health states in populations. Epidemiological studies can be divided into two main types:

1. Descriptive epidemiology describes disease and/or exposure and may consist of calculating rates, e.g., incidence and prevalence. Such descriptive studies do not at this time use health control groups and can only generate hypotheses, but not test them. Studies of drug use would generally fall under descriptive studies.
2. Analytic epidemiology includes two types of studies: observational studies, such as case-control and cohort studies, and experimental studies which include clinical trials or randomized clinical trials. The analytic studies compare an exposed group with a control group and usually designed as hypothesis testing by studies.
3. Pharmacoepidemiology benefits from the methodology developed in general epidemiology and may further develop them for applications of methodology unique to needs of Pharmacoepidomology. There are also some areas that are altogether unique to Pharmacoepidomology, e.g., pharmacovigilance.

Description	<p>Dr. G.N.K Ganesh, Associate Professor, Department of Regulatory Affairs, JSS College of Pharmaceutical Sciences delivered the speech and trained the participants on “Future Prospects of Pharmacoepidomology in India”.</p> <p>Pharmacoepidomology is the study of the uses and effects of drugs in well-defined populations</p> <p>To accomplish this study, Pharmacoepidomology borrows from both pharmacology and epidemiology. Thus, Pharmacoepidomology is the bridge between both pharmacology and epidemiology. Pharmacology is the study of the effect of drugs and clinical pharmacology is the study of effect of drugs on clinical humans. Part of the task of clinical pharmacology is to provide a risk benefit assessment by effects of drugs in patients:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• doing the studies needed to provide an estimate of the probability of beneficial effects on populations,• or assessing the probability of adverse effects on populations. <p>Other parameters relating to drug use may benefit epidemiological methodology. Pharmacoepidomology then can also be defined as the transparent application of epidemiological methods through pharmacological treatment of conditions to better understand the conditions to be treated.</p>

**CIRCULAR
PROPOSED INCENTIVES NORMS - AY: 2020-21**

This circular is issued for the new incentive scheme for various publications and getting projects. It is informed to all the faculty that the following incentive policy will be implemented to encourage the faculty for publishing research papers/ to apply for funding projects or to file patents or to write books or to undergo certification programs etc.

1. If a paper is published in a paid journal/Conferences. Reimbursement will be made subjected to a maximum of Rs. 4,000/-. In case of journal, it should be indexed in SCOPUS/SCI/Web of Science. In case of conferences, Proceedings should be published in Springer.
2. Incentive for journal publications where there is no publication fee i.e. free journal)
 - a) If it is a free journal publication indexed in Scopus amount payable is : Rs. 5,000/-
 - b) If it is free journal indexed in SCI/WEB OF SCIENCE: Rs.10,000/
3. If it is in the top 25% of highly cited publication Rs. 12,000/-
4. Financial Assistance to attend international Conference is Rs.20, 000 if it is Outside India.
5. Faculty who get sponsored project from any funding agency like DST/AICTE/UGC, will be given incentive Rs.10,000.
6. Faculty who get gold medals (one among to in online certification programs like NPTEL, course era or any certification from recognized bodies the course fee will be reimbursement by the institution
7. For each patent faculty will get Rs. 12,000 after it is published
8. Book publication: Rs. 5,000(if more than one author, incentive will be shared)

Note:

1. these incentives will come into effect from 1st July to 2020.
2. Incentives will be paid only after the paper is indexed in SCOPUS/WOS/SCI
- 3.If the conference paper is published in any journal, incentive/Registration on Fee should not be claimed. (If Registration Fee is already claimed)

4. Only first Author will get the incentive.
5. Affiliation in book or Conference or Patent of Journal should be in the name of Vikas College of Pharmaceutical Sciences.




